OPEN CALL COMPETITION CLIENT POLICY AGREEMENT:

Due to COVID-19, many theater and Open Call Competition logistics have changed. Below are noted some changes, expectations and rules for building entrants. By signing this agreement, you acknowledge that you will be dismissed from the competition and the building if found in violation of these rules.

- Dancers and their guests should arrive at the building no earlier than 45 minutes before their scheduled performance time. We will have a monitor assigned to check you and your guest in the door, and they will not be able to allow you to enter early. This helps us keep the dressing rooms and audience at a safe capacity.
- Dancers are not allowed in the audience. Due to audience capacity, only wrist banded and pre-announced guests will be allowed.
- Audience members must sit in the designated (and distanced) seats only. A monitor will be walking around to enforce this. All audience members must have a wristband with their name on it. - Dancers will not be able to rehearse in the lobby.
- 10 foot blocks will be marked in tape on the floor backstage for dancers in upcoming dances. This is a good place to rehearse, or in the backstage space.
- Dressing rooms will be designated by studio name and posted on the door. Do not enter another dressing room- this will heighten the risk of germ transmission.
- Awards can be viewed by live stream link, or by video sent out after they end. All award standings will be emailed ASAP, and all physical awards will be sent in the mail.
- Videos will be available to view during the event as we can accommodate, but no photos will be sold. You can pre-order your video by emailing opencallcomp@gmail.com (\$40 each) or order it by email during or after the event. Studio directors can contact me for video bundles.
- Any props that need special care or loading should be loaded and unloaded at a pre-booked time. Please email opencallcomp@gmail.com for available time slots.
- Cloth face masks must be worn at all times, even during performance. If you need to dance without a face mask, it must be approved in advance, and please email allison@opencallcompetition.com. A face shield is not allowed in lieu of a face mask.
- If you bring a water bottle, please have your name on it. Do not share items backstage
- All props must be loaded and unloaded at a pre-booked time with Open Call (that does not overlap another group's performance or loading time)
